## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA (2022-23)

- 1) Must have passed H.S. or equivalent from recognized board\*in 2022, 2021, 2020, 2019.
- 2) For admission to Pure Science Stream PASS in MATHEMATICS is compulsory.
- 3) For admission to HONOURS courses a student must have at least 45% in aggregate and 45 % in subject.
- 4) Students in Science or Commerce stream may apply for Humanities stream but not vice versa.
- 5) Students applying for Honours in available subjects must have studied the indicated subjects at H.S. Level in table below.



**\*Please check the list of recognized Boards before applying. No Refund of fees will be done for errors on applicant's part.**

- 6) Merit in a subject will be calculated as follows:

$$M = X + Y$$

Where M is Merit Point

X is Percentage obtained in H.S. or equivalent based on 1Best Language + 3 best subjects excluding Environmental Science and academically non-relevant subjects.

Y is Percentage obtained in Subject of Choice as defined below:

Computer Science	Computer Science or Mathematics/Physics whichever is higher.
Economics (Open Subject)	Best of 4 including 1 language subject. At the time of preparing the merit list preference will be given to those candidates who have studied Economics/Statistics/ Mathematics/Business Economics including Business Mathematics at 10+2 level Remaining seats will be filled up from candidates who have studied other subject except those mentioned above.

<b>Geography</b>	Best of 4 including 1 language subject + marks obtained in Mathematics/ Computer Science (From Science Mathematics/Computer Science) Best of 4 including 1 language + marks obtained in Economic Geography (From Commerce – Economic Geography) Best of 4 including 1 language subject + marks obtained in Geography (From Arts - Geography)
<b>History (Open Subject)</b>	History or English/Bengali whichever is higher
<b>Mathematics</b>	Mathematics
<b>Philosophy (Open Subject)</b>	Philosophy or English/Bengali whichever is higher
<b>Physics</b>	Physics
<b>Political Science (Open Subject)</b>	Political Science or English/Bengali whichever is higher
<b>Psychology (Open Subject)</b>	Best of 4 including 1 language subject. At the time of preparing the merit list preference will be given to those candidates who have studied Psychology/Biology / Statistics/Physiology/ Mathematics / Computer science at 10+2level. Remaining seats will be filled up from candidates who have studied other subject except those mentioned above. (From Science-Open, Commerce Open, Arts-Open)

7. Students from Vocational courses are eligible to apply for stream as follows:

8. Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) from recognized **Open Board** conducted by the recognized Open Higher Secondary Council shall be eligible to seek admission to the **Program Courses of Studies only**.
